EMPOWERMENT PROJECT

his project simultaneously focuses on economic, environmental and public health. Our target adopts the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) as set out by the United Nations. We have five main initiatives through this programme which include;

Food and

Nutrition







Aim: To reduce child malnutrition A number of initiatives are set which include education and training, provision of daily/weekly supplements, home visits and consultation.





Water **Wells**



Aim: To improve access to clean water This programme is to help a poor local communities build water reservoirs. The infrastructure scope of work will include drilling a one hundred metre deep water well and distribution through pipelines that will serve at least 50 households per water well

Sanitation



Aim: To improve access to basic sanitation This initiative involves health and sanitation training for the local community, the provision of education for primary healthcare workers to carry out a local campaign on environmental sanitation and to create collective self-built facilities for local communities, homes and public.

Small Business

Grant Scheme



Aim: To create capability for families to generate additional family income These series of activities involve supporting low income families with business planning strategy, implementation, coaching and mentoring.

We recommend this program to corporates or partners who would like to see impact and how the potential of local skills can boosted through education, training and coaching to help bring individuals and families out of poverty.





Aim: To create integrated village industries using existing local skills potential With your support this programme will provide a wider impacts to a local community. There are areas and villages which are endowed with natural resources or traditional skills which are key for this work. Together with our overseas partner, business plans and strategies will be carefully assessed and followed by building mini plan site or mass production. This programme also includes quality control monitoring and product certification.

Our Next Objective for Lombok

uman Aid Initiative focuses on recovery programmes which assist children back into normal education in particular those children who lost loved ones after the earthquake. The support will include psychosocial aid, school fee payment, food and healthcare for each child. We are currently looking for donors who would like to support these children through our Sponsor A Child programme.









With support from our donors, partners and local communities in the UK we were able to help those in desperate need with food aid, shelter kits, medical assistance, hygiene kits and the set up of an emergency community kitchen at several refugee points.

Our emergency relief does not stop here. Our emergency disaster initiatives continued with early response and recovery programmes for Indonesian tsunami victims. Human Aid Initiative were able to construct emergency bathroom units and provide tsunami survivors with access to clean water in two districts.





The devastation of the earthquake and tsunami also impacted children's education. Many schools were badly damaged and children were unable to attend school for a significant amount of time.

With the generosity and enormous support of our donors, our recovery programme extended to education by building four Initiative Schools for primary school children in the heavily affected villages of Jono Oge, Lasoani, Rarapadende and Pesaku.

This is a long-term initiative program for children who come from disadvantaged backgrounds.

de commenced our first year of child sponsorship in 2018 supporting children across various location in Indonesia who are currently living in foster care and orphanages.



Seasonal Programmes

Each year we also run two programmes over Ramadan and Eid ul-Adha.





We run a number of programmes during the holy month. We provide iftar meals, food aid, zakat and fidyah to the poor and needy as well as providing educational support to orphans.

Our Ramadan key themes this year were #FoodAid, #IftarZakatFidyah and #SponsorOrphan.

There were over 3,000 beneficiaries from this year campaign.



Qurbani



This programme is carried out during the pilgrimage season by distributing sacrificed qurbani meat to the poor and needy.

We carried out our first qurbani programme in September 2018. We distributed 200 qurbani packages to families in rural areas of East Indonesian regions such as Maluku and West Papua that can only be reached by foot from approximately 3km to the nearest village.

A large percentage of qurbani packages was also distributed to the survivors of the Lombok earthquake last year.

We work alongside PKPU Human Initiative*, our overseas partner in implementing projects and distributing relief funds. PKPU Human Initiative is one of the largest charity organisations in Indonesia with more than nineteen years of experience in delivering aid and emergency relief locally and also to other countries. It is one of a few charities that has access to remote and severely affected areas in Indonesia enabling them to deliver emergency relief and rescue to casualties and survivors.
